


Projected Amount of Costs Avoided Report – August 2022



- •Calculate costs avoided resulting from the enactment of AB 236
- •AB 236 promised to avoid \$640 million dollars in corrections costs from 2018 to 2028
- Prison population the lowest it has been since 2000
- •On track to avoid \$470 million in corrections construction
- On track to avoid \$170 million in additional costs

NSC Recommendations – Upfront Investment on Reinvestment


- •On track to avoid \$21 million in corrections costs per year
- •Invest \$42 million of costs avoided for two years since AB 236 was enacted
- Prioritize funding to the following:
 - o Programs and treatment at Department of Corrections
 - Reentry services and treatment programs at Parole and Probation
 - Behavioral health field response programs implemented by POST
 - Housing Division at Business and Industry
 - o Three million to the Nevada Local Justice Reinvestment Coordinating Council



Recommendation from NLJRCC

Appropriation to support NLJRCC

- Three million dollars to fund grants for programs and treatment
- Reduce recidivism



Priorities for grants

- •Programs for reentry, education, substance use, employment, and mental health
- Housing to support reentry of offenders
- Behavioral field response programs
