PUBLIC COMMENT

ADVISORY COMMISSION ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE

NOVEMBER 12, 2020

On Wednesday, October 28, 2020, the Nevada Sentencing Commission approved recommendations for technical corrections to Assembly Bill No. 236 (2019) as presented by the Nevada Department of Sentencing Policy. These recommendations included the following:

Amend NRS 176.01343

- o Remove data measures which no longer exist based on input from agencies
 - Impact
 - Ensure accuracy of data submitted
- Subsection 1 paragraph (f): Revise the requirements of the report where there are redundant or inconsistent requirements for the report required pursuant to subsection 11 of NRS 176.0134
 - Impact
 - Make each report distinct from the other

• Amend NRS 176.014

- Provide specific qualifications for members appointed to the Nevada Local Justice Reinvestment Coordinating Council
 - ➤ Impact
 - Assist governing bodies of each county in making their appointments
 - Ensure the Council can be the most effective in carrying out its duties

The Nevada Sentencing Commission will meet again on Wednesday, December 9, 2020, to discuss and approve additional recommendations for technical corrections to AB 236, if any. The Commission, with the assistance of the Nevada Department of Sentencing Policy, will also review impacts to costs avoided, savings, and reinvestment as a result of the enactment of AB 236 and the enactment of any legislation relating to the criminal justice system. (See subsection 1 paragraph (c) of NRS 176.01343)

The Nevada Department of Sentencing Policy can provide more detail and about any of these recommendations and looks forward to continued collaboration with the Advisory Commission on the Administration, the Legislature, and other stakeholders in the criminal justice system.
