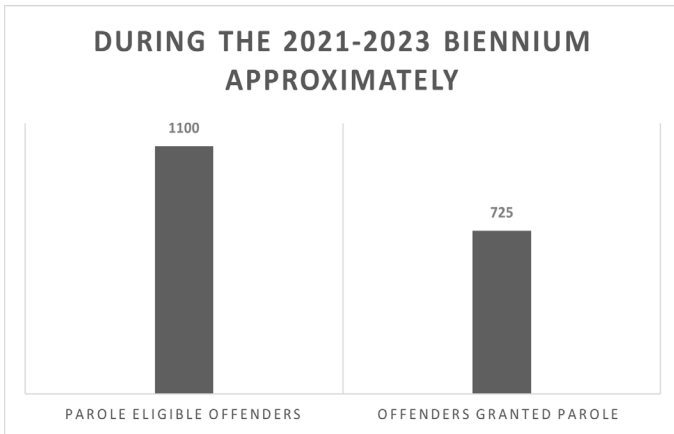

Potential Impacts During the 2021-2023 Biennium Resulting from the Enactment of AB 125



Possible cost savings during the 2021-2023 biennium
\$21,426,686.25*
 (this calculation based on the average cost per inmate included in Governor Sisolak's 2021-2023 Recommended Budget)

*Savings and fiscal impacts to all agencies could be impacted by recidivism. The recidivism rate for category B felons for the 2016 cohort is 21.6%.



- NDOC - \$144,470 (21-23 Biennium)
- Parole Board - \$255,748 (21-23 Biennium)
- NPP - \$3,357,320 (21-23 Biennium)

IMPACTS

NDOC – Recalculate sentences for all eligible offenders

Parole Board – Conduct additional hearings for eligible offenders

NDOC –House fewer offenders than projected in the 2021-23 biennium

NPP– Supervise additional eligible offenders

The approximate cost savings if the fiscal impacts are considered would be *\$17,669,148.25*

The offender population in future biennia will likely be impacted by sentence recalculations and will result in ongoing increased staffing needs to:

- Recalculate offender sentences - \$161,710.00 (NDOC Future Biennia)
- Conduct additional Parole board hearings - \$220,424.00 (PB Future Biennia)
- Supervise additional caseloads for NPP - \$3,121,100.00 (NPP Future Biennia)
