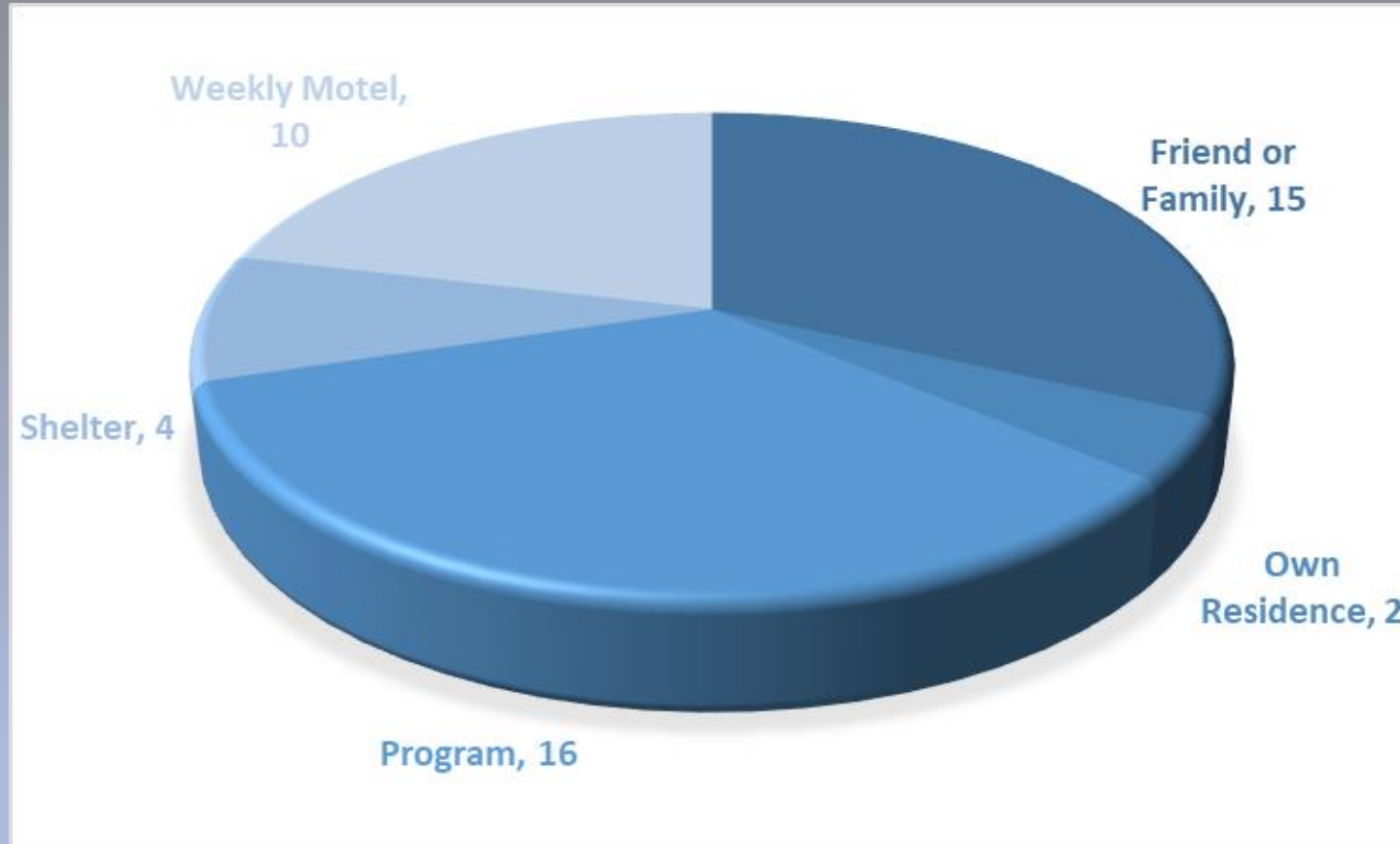

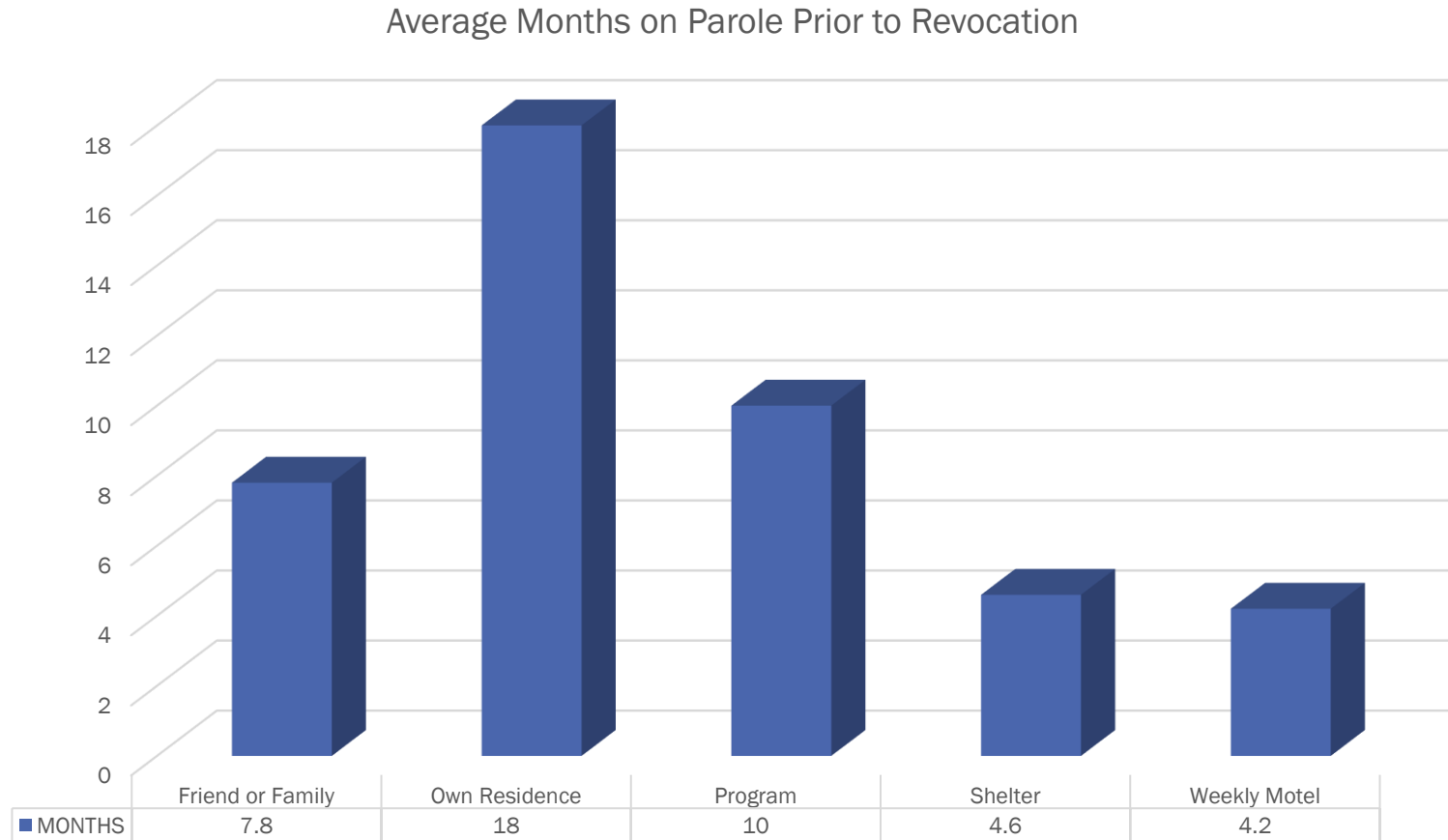


NRS 213.140 provides the authority that a housing plan must be approved by the Division of Parole and Probation prior to a parolee being released.

Approved Release Plans

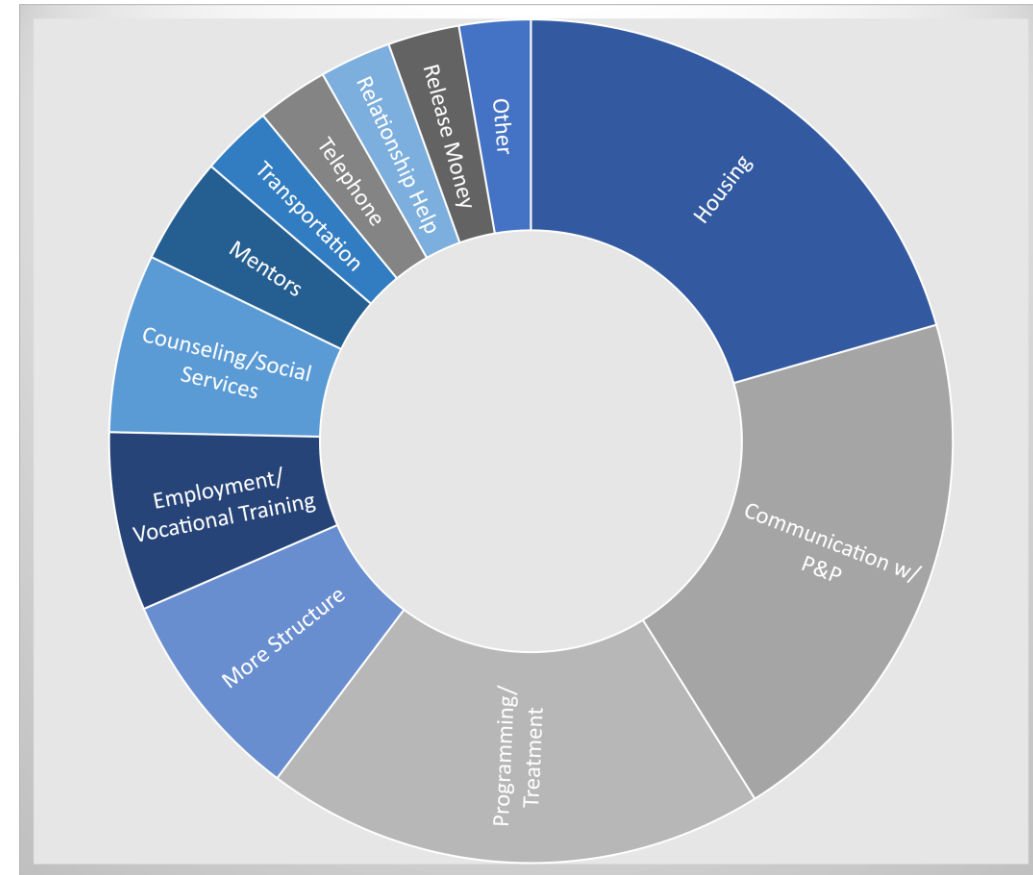
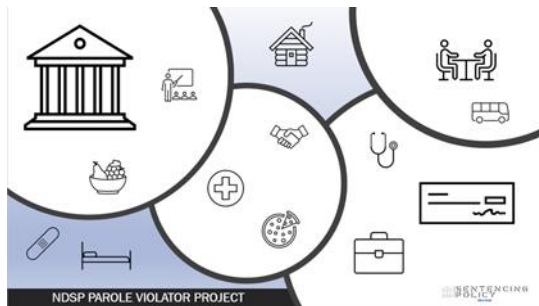


AVERAGE TIME ON PAROLE PRIOR TO REVOCATION BY RELEASE PLAN TYPE
