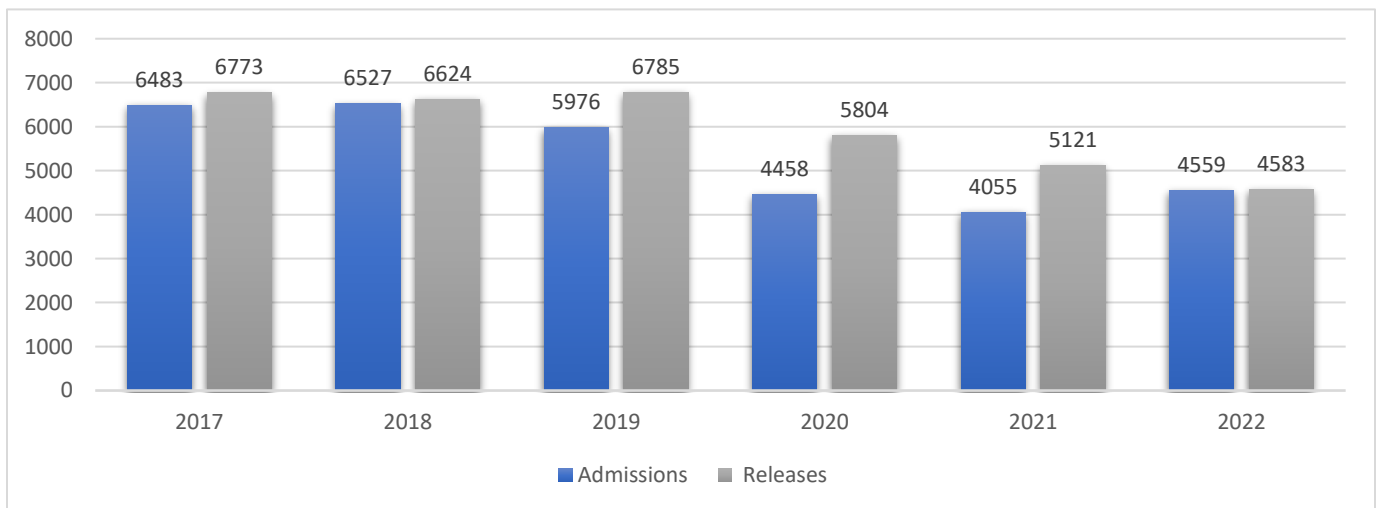

February Discoveries

- Between 2018 and 2021 admissions and releases decreased, while in 2022 admissions increased and releases continued to decrease
- The prison population saw a slight increase in December 2022 but decreased in January 2023
- The prison population will continue to decrease if releases outpace admissions
