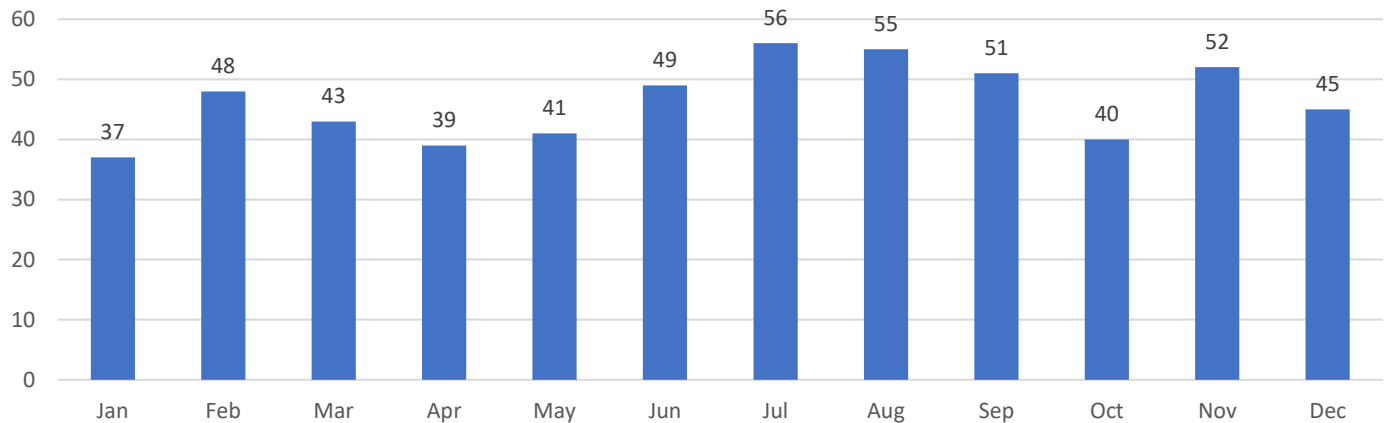

- The graph above includes 30, 90, and 180 day - temporary revocations
- Temporary revocations are imposed for technical violations of conditions of supervision
- Parolees serve temporary revocations in an NDOC facility
- Based on the data, the three highest months were July, August, and November
