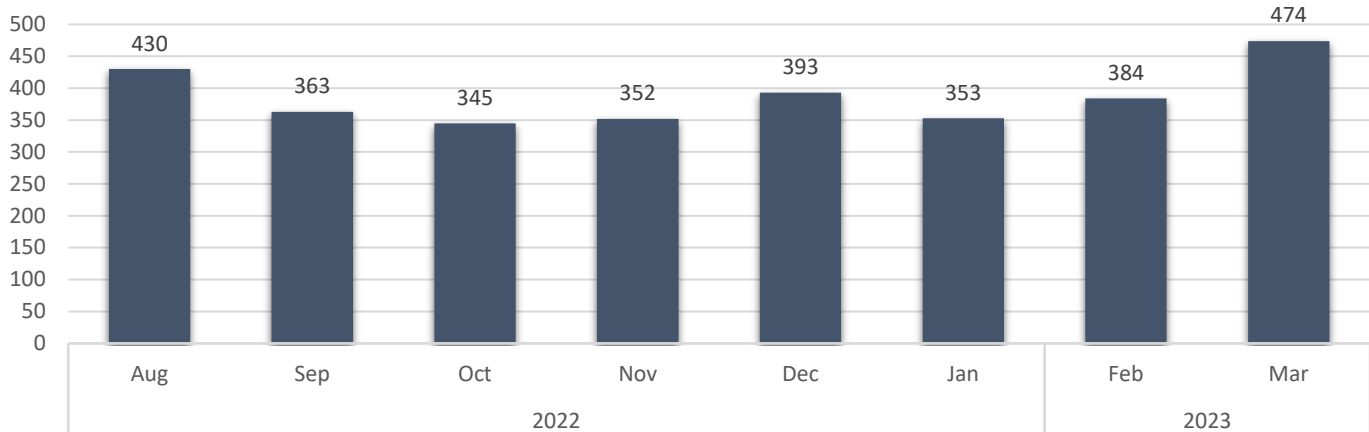

- The highest three offense groups in admissions are Violence, Property, and Other
