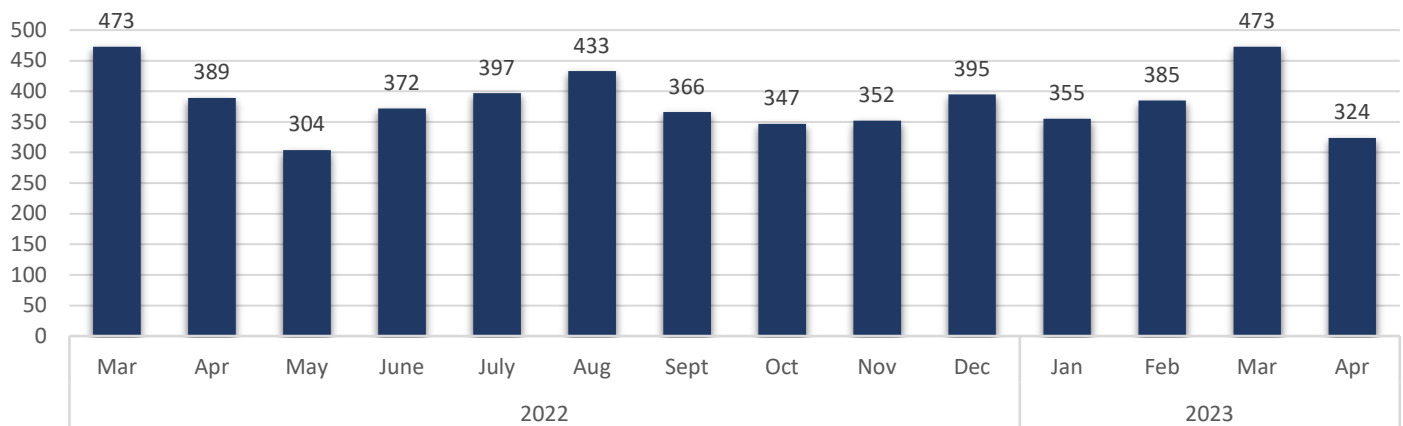

#### May Discoveries

- The graph above illustrates the NDOC admissions over the last year
- There was a decrease in admissions from March 2023 to April 2023
- This was the largest month-to-month drop in admissions going back to 2015
- The two offense groups that saw the largest decrease were Violence & Property
