<a href="#">2.250 &amp; 2.255</a>	Unauthorized fees charged by Clerk of Supreme Court	Added 1985. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">3.130</a>	District judge accepting gratuity for performing marriage	Added 1955. Never amended.
<a href="#">4.080 &amp; 4.120</a>	Unauthorized/excessive fees charged by justice of the peace	Added 1969. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">4.090 &amp; 4.120</a>	Justice of the peace failure to keep fee book open to public inspection	Added 1883. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">4.100</a>	Justice of the peace failure to file monthly financial statement	Added 1883. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">4.220</a>	Unlawful purchase of judgments by justice of the peace	Added 1866. Only penalty amounts changed.
<a href="#">19.035 &amp; 19.110</a>	Unauthorized fee charged or collected by clerk of court (county clerk, district court)	Added 1963. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">19.070</a>	County clerk charging more or greater fees	Added 1883. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">19.080</a>	Failure to keep fee book or electronic record open for public inspection (county clerk)	Added 1883. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">19.090</a>	Failure to file monthly financial statement (clerk of district court)	Added 1883. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">199.270</a>	Refusal to make arrest or assist officer	Makes it a misdemeanor for a citizen to refuse a command/request by an officer or magistrate to make or assist in an arrest. Dates from before 1911 and has never been amended.
<a href="#">199.350</a>	Grand juror acting after challenge allowed	It is a misdemeanor for grand juror to take part in a grand jury proceeding after a challenge to that grand juror by the defendant is allowed. Dates from before 1911 and has never been amended.
<a href="#">200.550</a>	Furnishing libelous information	It is a misdemeanor for a person to give a journalist information that, if published, would be libel. Dates from before 1911 and has never been amended.
<a href="#">201.249</a>	Production, distribution, exhibition, and possession items or materials	Specifically excluded child related materials. Definition of obscenity in 201.235.
<a href="#">201.251</a>	Coercing acceptance of obscene articles or publications	Makes it a crime to require someone to accept obscene materials as part of a commercial transaction. Added 1979 and never updated.
<a href="#">201.253</a>	Obscene, indecent, or immoral shows, acts, or performances.	Added 1883. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#">201.270</a>	Disturbing a religious meeting	Makes it a misdemeanor to, among other things, disturb a religious assembly by rude or noisy behavior. Dates from before 1911 and has never been amended.
<a href="#">201.280</a>	Selling liquor at a camp meeting for religious worship	Prohibits sale of liquor within 1 mile of a religious camp meeting. Dates from before 1911 and amended once in 1967.

## Misdemeanors to Recommend for Repeal

<a href="#">202.210</a>	Publication of advertisement for goods and services to produce a miscarriage	Dates from before 1911 and updated once in 1967. Underlying advertisement is a gross misdemeanor.
<a href="#">202.220</a>	Circulation of a publication with miscarriage advertisement	Dates from before 1911 and updated once in 1967. Underlying advertisement is a gross misdemeanor.
<a href="#">202.240</a>	Advertising treatment, cure, or prevention of sexual disorders	Dates from 1921. Amended in 1967 and 1985.
<a href="#">202.245</a>	Operating of a shoe-fitting device or machine using fluoroscopy, x-ray, or radiation	Created in 1960. Amended in 1985.
<a href="#">202.510</a>	Doors of public building must swing outwards	Dates from before 1911. Now covered by building codes.
<a href="#">202.540</a>	Dangerous exhibitions	Dates from before 1911. Seems to contemplate "wild west" type shows.
<a href="#">206.330</a>	Placing graffiti on or otherwise defacing property where the value of loss is less than \$250	NRS 206.340 imposes a \$250 administrative assessment (AA) to be deposited in a fund that last appeared in the state budget in 2019. Recommend elimination of AA.
<a href="#">207.030</a>	Prohibited acts related to vagrancy	This statute includes a number of valid prohibitions. Recommend it be rewritten to remove certain parts related to being unhoused or loitering, i.e., amend don't repeal.
<a href="#">207.163</a>	Refusal to relinquish public telephone for emergency calls; false declaration of emergency to obtain use of public telephone	Added 1973; amended in 2001 to remove reference to "party line".
<a href="#">202.165</a>	Failure to include notice of offense in 202.163 in phonebook (directory)	Added in 1973. Never updated.
<a href="#">202.270</a>	Loitering about public school or public place where children congregate	Added in 1963 and amended in 1967. Is it overbroad?
<a href="#">212.180</a>	Sale of liquor within one-half mile of institution of the Department of Corrections	Added in 1979. Amended in 2021 to allow at fundraiser for historic preservation.
<a href="#">243.485</a>	Neglect or refusal by county commissioner or official to remove records, offices, property, and prisoners to new county seat	Added 1953 and never amended. Last county seat change in NV was 1979 in Lander County.
<a href="#">248.210</a>	Neglecting or refusing to exercise authority concerning riotous assembly (sheriff)	Dates from 1866. Never amended. Misdemeanor for sheriff or deputies to refuse to arrest persons engaged in riotous assembly.
<a href="#">268.030</a>	Failure to publish quarterly financial statements ((city or county clerk)	Dates from 1943. Amended in 1967 and 2011 (technical corrections).
<a href="#">269.013</a>	Unlawful use of name by another political subdivision	Added 1959. Never amended.
<a href="#">269.230</a>	Neglecting or refusing to exercise authority concerning riotous assembly (sheriff, constable, or justice of the peace)	Dates from 1866. Never amended.
<a href="#">331.190</a>	Sale, gift, or disposal of liquor within Capitol Building	Dates from before 1911. Never amended.
<a href="#">331.200</a>	Damage to or destruction of capitol grounds or other state property	Crime to walk on and damage grass on state property or to damage any tree, shrub, or "other thing". Added 1899.
<a href="#">353.080</a>	Failure of legislative auditor to perform duties	Added 1953. Amended 1973 (LCB).

<a href="#"><u>353.260</u></a>	Spending in excess of amount appropriated by a person other than a state officer	Added 1969. No non-technical amendments.
<a href="#"><u>386.830</u></a>	Superintendent of schools failure or refusal to repair defects of bus or other vehicle used to transport pupils within 20 days of notice from DPS	Crime dates to 1957. Remove criminal penalty only?
<a href="#"><u>386.840</u></a>	Superintendent of schools failure or refusal to repair defects of system used for loading or unloading of bus or other vehicle used to transport pupils within 20 days of notice from DPS	Crime dates to 1957. Remove criminal penalty only?
<a href="#"><u>393.0715</u></a>	Use of grant of use of program or movement to accomplish overthrow of government	Added 1959. "Red Scare" legislation.
<a href="#"><u>393.170</u></a>	Violations of provisions concerning library books, textbooks, or other school supplies.	Added in 1967. Amended from "shall" to "must" in 1991.
<a href="#"><u>394.700</u></a>	Use of false or misleading degree or honorary degree conferred by a private entity	Includes out-of-range fine of \$5,000.
<a href="#"><u>396.990</u></a>	Use of false or misleading degree (NSHE)	Includes out-of-range fine of \$5,000.
<a href="#"><u>428.110</u></a>	Bringing nonresident indigent person into a county	Added 1967. Amended 1989.
<a href="#"><u>445A.015</u></a>	Failure to appropriately adjust concentration of fluoride in water	Added 1967. Never amended.
<a href="#"><u>445B.640</u></a>	Failure to pay a fine concerning air pollution within 30 days after imposition	Statute includes civil penalties of up to \$10,000/day. Misdemeanor doesn't make sense.
<a href="#"><u>475.110</u></a>	Refusal by able-bodied male to assist in extinguishing fire in timber or brush	Added in 1927. Later changes deal with workers' comp /Silver State Industrial Insurance issues.
<a href="#"><u>520.110</u></a>	Failure to comply with NRS 520.110, "right of stockholders to inspect a company's mines"	Added 1879. Seems like it imposes a potential liability on mine operators.
<a href="#"><u>609.245</u></a>	Employment of a child under 14 years old without written permission of district judge or designee	Added prior to 1911. Non non-technical amendments. Eliminate district judge permission?
